A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to establish an expenditure limit with respect to candidates for the House of Representatives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Campaign Account-
5 ability and Parity Act” or the “CAP Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIMIT FOR HOUSE OF REP-**
2 **RESENTATIVES CANDIDATES.**

3 Title III of the Federal Election Campaign Act of
4 1971 (52 U.S.C. 30101 et seq.) is amended by adding at
5 the end the following:

6 **“SEC. 325. ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIMIT FOR HOUSE OF**
7 **REPRESENTATIVES CANDIDATES.**

8 “The principal campaign committee of a candidate
9 for the office of Representative in, or Delegate or Resident
10 Commissioner to, the House of Representatives may not
11 make in a year expenditures aggregating in excess of the
12 average amount made available for use in the previous
13 year by a Member of the House of Representatives from
14 the Members’ Representational Allowance established in
15 section 101 of the House of Representatives Administra-
16 tive Reform Technical Corrections Act (2 U.S.C. 5341).”.
