1	SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF VETERANS ADVOCATE.
2	(a) In General.—Title III of the Robert T. Stafford
3	Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (15 U.S.C.
4	5141 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5	lowing:
6	"SEC. 328. DESIGNATION OF VETERAN ADVOCATE.
7	"(a) In General.—The President shall designate in
8	the Federal Emergency Management Agency a Veteran
9	Advocate.
10	"(b) Responsibilities.—The Veterans Advocate
11	shall be an advocate for the fair treatment of veterans in
